

FACTORIES – CLEANING OF MACHINERY IN MOTION

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by Section 34 of the Factories Ordinance, 1946 the following order is hereby made: -

1. This Order may be cited as the Factories (Cleaning of Machinery in Motion) Order, 1949.
2. The provisions of Section 19 of the Factories Ordinance, 1946 shall not apply to any male person of twenty-one years or over in respect of any prime mover, transmission machinery or other machinery which is required to be kept in motion for a continuous period of not less than seven days and seven nights during any such time when such prime mover, transmission machinery or other machine is in motion and it is the duty of such male person to maintain the prime mover, transmission machinery or other machine in as clean condition.
